


Introduction

- In our house, we called this "Pulling A Louie"


Became a Ham in 1963

- Emergency and Priority communication needed for the Clinic
- Tested as a Mail-In Candidate and was issued General (Provisional) license - KL7DZQ
- License expired in 1973 after we moved to "The Lower 48"

- Retrieved his original callsign after proving use in the 1960s - KL7DZQ
